Some of the money went to reserves – this is money that is saved in the bank to cover expenses if something unexpected happens. Some of the money was spent on things like event materials.

New Members' council theme for 2025



In our previous meeting we planned for a new theme for our meetings in 2025.

We agreed that "advocacy" theme would be a good way to combine different important topics, like how to ask for help or how to support your peers, if they need help, or how to speak up for yourself.

We spoke about what advocacy means, and what kind of projects we could do, like making an informational video about it, raising awareness by sharing leaflets, writing to People Matters newsletter.

We spoke about choosing a chair for Members' council meetings, like what the role involves.
